

Morgan County Club Rules

Effective 01/30/10



50-Bird Program

50-Bird Program consists of 25-16 yard targets and 25-ATA Handicap targets with 20-yard minimum. High score for the day earns one (1) yard for one (1) year from date earned. If shooter has high score with newly assigned yardage, another yard is earned for one (1) year from that date. If shooter breaks 50-straight one (1) yard is earned permanently. Shooter must play jackpot option each time they shoot the program to be eligible.

Payout of jackpot monies:

1st, 2nd, & 3rd times shooting the program & a shooter runs 50-straight, is eligible for 25% of one-half of the jackpot.

4th time shooting the program & run 50-straight payout is 50% of total jackpot

Shooter remains eligible from 4th time shooting the program for one-half of jackpot.

Maximum payout is \$500.

100-Bird Handicap Program

100-Bird Handicap Program is a non-registered program with ATA assigned yardage used with a 20-yard minimum yardage. Five (5) or more shooters playing the purse &/or 50's options will earn high score one (1) yard for one (1) year. If the shooter has high score with the newly assigned yardage, another yard is earned for one (1) year from that date. If shooter breaks first, middle, or last 50 targets one (1) yard is earned which is permanent until the same shooter breaks another 50-straight, at which time another yard is earned. Shooter must play 50's jackpot option each time they shoot the program to be eligible.

Payout of jackpot (3) 50's monies:

1st, 2nd, & 3rd times shooting the program & run 50-straight payout is 10% of 70% of total jackpot

4th time shooting the program & run a 50-straight payout is 30% of 70% of total jackpot

5th time shooting the program & run a 50-straight payout is 50% of 70% of total jackpot

6th time shooting the program & run a 50-straight payout is 70% of total jackpot. Shooter

remains eligible from 6th time shooting the program for jackpot monies.

Maximum jackpot in each 50 totals \$750 with 70% payout.

Rules changed by management and trustees as conditions warrant. Club management has option to revise shooter's yardage.

Club Rules

1. All shotgun actions are to be kept open unless being fired, on a stand, or cased.
2. No shooting shot larger than #7 ½
3. Always point muzzle of shotgun in a safe direction
4. Eye and ear protection are required when shooting
5. Never load gun until your on the shooting line
6. Never change stations with a shell in the chamber
7. All shooters must open actions and unload before anyone moves forward from the firing line to the service trap
8. Shoot only at your own target, and from a designated shooting site
9. Be sure range is clear before commencing to fire
10. As a courtesy to others, please pick up your trash from the grounds
